

## **Guidance Counselor Job Description**

The Guidance Counselor will serve as a guide who helps direct the students' activities academically, spiritually, emotionally, and physically in a prepared Montessori environment that challenges each child to reach his/her fullest potential in these developmental areas, while always upholding the Montessori philosophy and the school's mission.

## Required Qualifications:

- Master's Degree
- Have two years of educational or work related experience.
- NC State License preferred
- Have the ability to cooperate with staff, parents/guardians, administration and community resource people
- Be able to demonstrate effective communication skills
- Have the ability to develop rapport with student
- Be able to analyze and offer problem-solving techniques
- Have patience
- Be able to empathize and understand students' concerns

## Responsibilities:

- Assist students with academic, emotional, social or behavioral problems
- Show concern for the total need of each student (educational, vocational, personal and social), encouraging maximum growth and development
- Consult with parents/guardians, teachers, support staff, administration and any local agencies which might be of assistance to the students
- Provide parents/guardians with accurate, comprehensive and relevant information in an objective and caring manner
- Work with staff to enhance understanding of all aspects of the student's development and its impact on learning
- Serve as the school's McKinney-Vento Liason and complete all required documentation
- Assist parents/guardians in helping students set and achieve goals
- Aid students in understanding the school environment and what is expected of them
- Aid students in understanding their strengths and abilities so they may learn more effectively.
- Teach conflict resolution skills
- Aid students in acquiring an understanding and respect for individual freedoms and rights of self and others
- Aid in the understanding of the consequences of actions for self and others
- Assist students in dealing with a family crisis (e.g., separation, divorce, death, neglect and abuse, unemployment and alcoholism)
- Refer and support students with 504 plans
- Provide orientation and registration for students who are entering high school
- Serve as member of the MTSS Team
- Provide individual parent conferences for students when necessary
- Conduct parent workshops when necessary or requested



- Provide individual conferences for students experiencing academic or emotional difficulty
- Keep accurate records of all counseling and guidance activities
- Assist in administering standardized testing
- Write articles for the school newsletter
- Inform administration of various student's needs or issues
- Assist in appropriate student referrals
- Assist in the development of an individualized education plan for students with exceptional educational needs
- Participate in home visits upon request
- Make appropriate referrals to community agencies when necessary
- Serve as consultant to parents/guardians, staff and administration
- Protect the confidentiality of student records and release personal data in accordance with state laws and Board policies
- Establish and maintain a cooperative relationship with faculty, staff and administration to facilitate the provision of optimum guidance and counseling services
- Work with the administration on additional activities as necessary
- Perform other duties as may be assigned
