- I am working on our community calendar for our donation drives/awareness months. Since Montessori operates on a three year cycle, my aim is to have that follow with our serving as well. Below is the current proposal for this year but I am still waiting to hear back from organizations on what needs they have.
- The administrative team took a tour of the Harrelson Center this summer to really connect with local non-profit organizations. The hope was to foster a desire for ways to connect students/classrooms and staff to the community for serving.
